Estate Administration Tax Act - Estate Information Return

As the Ontario Ministry of Finance moves forward with its oversight responsibilities of Ontario's Estate Administration Tax Act, 1998, the Ministry has asked for STEP Canada's assistance to ensure stakeholders are fully aware of the options available to them when submitting an Estate Information Return.

STEP Canada is pleased to deliver this message from the Ministry to its members.

Beginning January 1, 2015, an Estate Information Return must be received by the Ministry of Finance within 90 calendar days after a Certificate of Appointment of Estate Trustee has been issued by the court. However, this does not apply to anyone who applied to the court for a Certificate of Appointment of Estate Trustee prior to January 1, 2015.

A fillable PDF version of the <u>Estate Information Return</u> is available on the ministry's website, <u>ontario.ca/finance</u>, under the "Forms and Publications" link on the left side. Its accompanying <u>Guide</u> is available on the website as well. The Estate Information Return may be filled out on-line and printed, or it may be printed and filled out by hand, before submitting it to the Ministry of Finance.
