The 2015 Federal Budget will be tabled by Finance Minister Joe Oliver in the House of Commons on Tuesday, April 21, 2015. STEP Canada has participated in consultations with the Department of Finance relating to legislative amendments (Bill C-43) enacted on December 16, 2014 (effective as of 2016) which contain amendments to the taxation of testamentary trusts and estates that will have broad implications to estate planning. It is hoped that Budget 2015 will contain additional measures to address the potentially adverse consequences that have been identified.
